Who is Eligible

All students in grades 6-12 in San Diego County plus all dependents in grades 6-12 of active duty military personnel (USMC, Navy, Air Force, Army and National Guard) based in the Southwest region are eligible.

Subject Matter:

- ☞ All aspects of Marine Corps Aviation, both past and present.

Eligibility & Requirements

- ☞ One entry per student.
- ☞ Artwork must be two dimensional. Mediums accepted include colored pencil, pastels, charcoal, watercolors, mixed media, oils and acrylics. Oils and acrylics must be painted on canvas board (No photographs or computer generated art.)
- ☞ All entries must be completed in a 11x14 format.
- ☞ Submit title and inspiration behind the artwork.
- ☞ All entries must be submitted in a digital format thru the website.
- ☞ Each entry must be original in concept, design, and execution and may not violate U.S. copyright law.
- ☞ Finalists will be contacted in April and required to have a permission form signed by a guardian.
- ☞ Finalists must mail or drop off the original artwork at the museum.

All winning artwork will be framed and put on display at the Flying Leatherneck Aviation Museum
